DRIVER'S NOTE

Thank you for agreeing to serve as a driver for an activity! **Our goal is to help keep our youth safe at all times, even traveling to and from events.** You're responsible for the youth while they are in the vehicle with you.

The **Top 10** things you need to know as a driver before we leave:

1. Be sure your vehicle is full of gas and oil and in good operating condition.
2. Please arrive at the church at least 15 minutes prior to our scheduled meeting time to receive maps, special instructions, exchange cell numbers, etc.
3. Headcount, headcount, headcount! Be sure you know how many youth are in your vehicle and who they are. These same youth should travel back with you.
4. Practice the buddy system. When two or more cars are driving to an activity, stay together (If there are many cars, pair up).
5. Drive with your headlights on for better visibility. If you need to pull over, put your flashers on to alert the other vehicle.
6. Please be cautious in all your driving decisions. Take no risks whatsoever. Obey all speed limits and other traffic laws. Always wear your seatbelt and require all youth to buckle up before you leave. Safety is imperative.
7. All passengers must be properly restrained with a safety belt and each safety belt must be properly anchored and used according to the manufacturer's specifications, and in good working order. Safety approved car or booster seats must be used for all children under the age of 10 years. All passengers must remain seated and properly restrained by the safety belt while the vehicle is in motion. All passengers must be transported in accordance with the manufacturer's rated seating capacity and designated seating position.
8. If there are any problems while driving, you are in charge. Tell the leader in charge (Point Person) if any youth cause trouble so it can be handled properly.
9. Check your vehicle after the event to make sure the youth have removed their belongings and their trash. Make sure they clean up their own trash!!
10. Remember...you're a part of our youth ministry team. Get to know the youth and have fun on the activity!
